On behalf of Fr. Tom Willis and the Cathedral Parish School Board, we are pleased to provide you with our Annual Report for the 2017-18 school year. We have had a wonderful year thanks to our faithful families, students, faculty and staff. So many exciting things are happening! We will soon be rolling out our brand new website thanks to Pierre and Melinda Le Poureau. We believe you will find it extremely interactive, informative and helpful.

Fundraising efforts make it possible for us to enhance our program offerings at Cathedral Parish School. The PTO Board (with your help) has had a successful year with our Barnes and Noble Book Fair and the Tringali Barn "Night Under the Stars" events. The Le Poureau family has taken on the Chairmanship of the Legacy of Faith Sponsorship Program for our school. While they had a late start, they have managed to reach out to many businesses and families and we are grateful for their sponsorship of Cathedral Parish School. The festival funds pay our existing mortgage and we thank Kevin Partel and our faithful volunteers for another incredible year as the 2018 Festival brought in over \$186,000 for our Parish.


Attached you will see a breakdown by percentage for our school's income and expenses during the 2017-18 school year. It is helpful for families to know the true cost of educating one child at Cathedral Parish School this year was \$6,880.00. Keeping in mind we collect \$2400 in tuition per child for our VPK children and with our multiple student discounts, you can see we must depend upon outside sources and revenues to meet our budgetary demands. In addition to our fundraising efforts which are a huge help, we rely upon After Care and Summer Camp income, fees, bequests and donations.

In an effort to streamline our tuition collection, this year we included textbook and technology fees within our cost of tuition. We thank our participating parishes for taking care of the active parishioners' book and technology fee portion of their tuition expense and we thank those parishes providing scholarships to families applying for assistance to attend Cathedral Parish School.

The Diocese of St. Augustine Catholic Schools had the highest achievement test scores (ITBS) in the state. We also outscore the Nation. At CPS our English and Reading scores are higher than our diocesan counterparts, which means our students out-perform the diocese and the state. Our writing program is exceptional. We have implemented a new math program and are looking forward to an increase in student progress at all grade levels.

We hope you all have a wonderful summer and look forward to the 2018-19 school year.

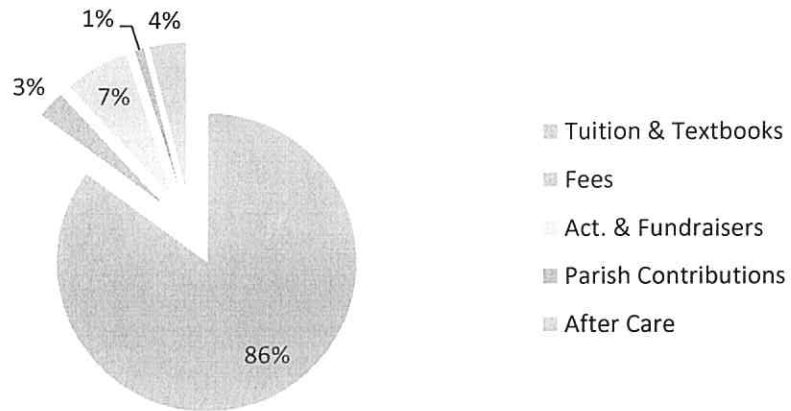

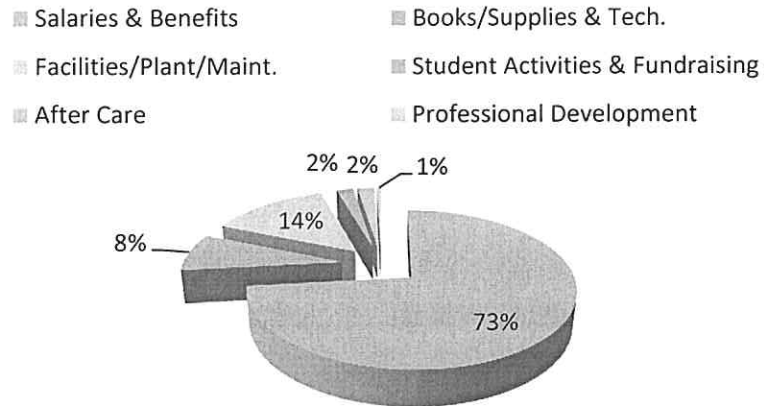
